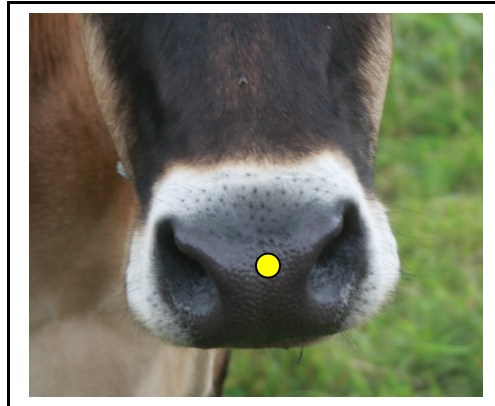


APPETITE STIMULATION POINTS FOR RUMINANTS



- **Needle this point to assist with appetite stimulation in ruminants**
- **The point is on the top of the muzzle where the haired skin meets the hairless skin of the muzzle**
- **Insert a 20 or 18 gauge needle at this point, penetrating the skin until you feel the firm tissue beneath with the tip of the needle, approximately ¼ to ½ inch**
- **This will be performed easiest with the head haltered and pulled to the side, as you would while administering intravenous fluids; the needle is left in place for 10-20 minutes**
